Under the Fountain of Love Department, Form I students and staff had one week of teaching with the lower grades, FOZ & FOJ about hearing God's voice. Many were encouraged by this teaching.

Fountain of Love held a camp for Grade 7. It was held in Machame and the Spirit of God moved mightily among them. They were ministered to by several of the NLF staff. They had a time to hear from God for themselves and they also had a talk about discipline issues.

Fountain of Love is still doing outreach to the children's prison. In the past 2 months 3 more children

have accepted Christ and they are doing very well spiritually.

In July, Fountain of Love along with New Life Foundation hosted a week long crusade in Moshi. The crusade was located in the center of town at a place called Hindu Mandal. The grounds are outdoors for the Hindu's to play sports, etc. During that time there was a team from New Zealand here and they participated in the crusade by testimony, drama and music. Part of the team included Pastor Peter Clerk. He gave powerful, anointed messages. There were about 120 people/children that gave

their lives to the Lord. The bus driver, who was Muslim, for the New Zealand team also got saved on the last night. There were also many people that gave testimony of healing in their bodies. There was an older gentleman that came to the crusade on crutches. He got prayed for and walked without his crutches on stage in front of everyone. There was also a young lady that had stomach problems and was not able to eat well for 4 years. She was taking medication but it was really expensive. She told the Lord that she didn't want to take the medication anymore, that she wanted to be healed. She got prayed for

and God healed her. She is now able to eat well. So many testimonies of healing. One the last night of the crusade, an opportunity was given to those who wanted to be water baptized. There were several people that made the decision and a Form I student from Fountain of Hope also got baptized. Praise the Lord! We are very thankful for God's hand at work during this crusade.
