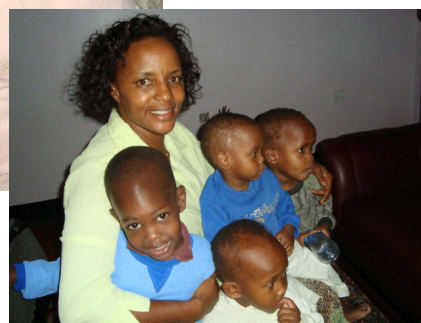
Upcoming teams visiting New Life Foundation:

Fountain of Love have continually pursued out reach in the month on March and on one occasion saw over 50 children filled with the Holy Spirit in the Moshi children's prison.

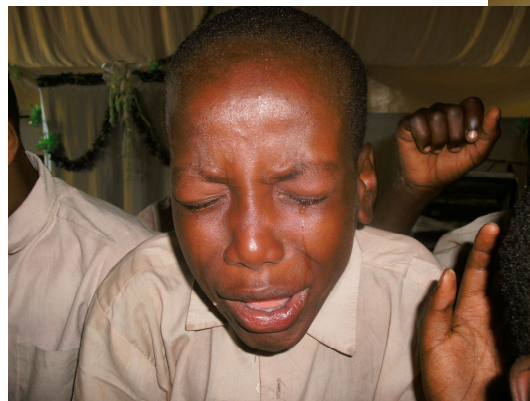
FOL also had their School of Ministry in Arusha on 20th March. This was a stimulating time and the team gained much more understanding in their field of outreach.
